All Classes Judged indoors 9am start Judge: Mr J Hunton

- Class 1. Lead rein Working Hunter. Riders 8yrs and under. Jumps max 40cm
- Class 2. Tiny Tots Working Hunter. Riders 10yrs and under. Jumps max 50cm.
- Class 3. Unaffiliated Beginner Working Hunter. Open to all horses/ponies and any age rider – jumps max 60cms.
- Class 4. Unaffiliated Working Hunter. Open to all horses and ponies. Jumps max 70cm

Championship Classes 1 – 4

Conformation will be judged separately

- Class 5. Cradle Stakes. Mare or gelding, 4 yrs old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st Jan. in the current year.
- Class 6. BSPS Novice Nursery Stakes. Mare or gelding 4yrs old or over not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1/1/12
- Class 7. BSPS Open (restricted) Nursery Stakes. Mare or gelding 4yrs old or over not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1/1/12

Mini WHP Championship for 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 5 – 7.

- Class 8. BSPS Novice WHP. Mare or gelding 4yrs old or over not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1/1/12
- Class 9. BSPS Novice WHP. Mare or gelding 4yrs old or over exceeding 133cms and not exceeding 143cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1/1/12

Class 10. BSPS Novice WHP. Mare or gelding 4yrs old and over exceeding 143cms and not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1/1/12

Class 11. BSPS Novice Intermediate WHP. Mare or gelding 4yrs old and over exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1/1/12.

Novice Championship 1st & 2nd prize-winners from classes 8 – 11 inc

Class 12. BSPS Open (restricted) Mixed Height WHP/WH. Mare or gelding 4yrs old and over not exceeding 158cms. Riders must jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of animal they ride. Riders must declare if they are competing in 153cms or intermediate section. Riders may ride more than one animal providing they are of different height sections. Animals may not compete in the 153cm class and the intermediate class at the same show in the same section. Intermediate section will jump first.

Class 13. **The “Ruth Lears” Challenge** Novice Working Hunter. Mare or gelding, 4yrs old and over, exceeding 153cms. Riders any age. Min fence height 2`9” max 3`3”. The first 3 to qualify for the BSPS Winter Championship Show.

Class 14. BSPS Heritage Mountain and Moorland Novice WHP. Mixed Height. Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4yrs old and over. Riders any age. Ponies must jump their correct height section. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are of a different height section.

Class 15. BSPS Heritage Mountain and Moorland Open/Restricted WHP. Mixed height. Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4yrs old and over. Riders any age. Ponies must jump their correct height section. Riders may ride more than one pony providing they are of a different height section.

Heritage Qualification

Any animal that has qualified for the M & M WHP or M & M ridden classes at Olympia, HOYS or RIHS in the previous or the current year are not eligible for restricted qualification. The 3 highest placed restricted and 3 highest places overall in the Open Lead rein, First ridden, WHP and ridden classes will qualify. **Eligible Restricted Riders MUST wear an Armband.** In the mixed height novice classes 1st 2nd 3rd and 4th placed ponies will qualify. In mixed height open (restricted) the 4 highest placed restricted animals will qualify for the restricted section. Exhibitors in qualifying positions who have never been members before are allowed 7 days to register.

BSPS Qualification

The 3 highest placed ponies will qualify in all Novice classes. In mixed height novice classes the 4 highest placed ponies will qualify. In the Open 3 highest placed ponies overall will qualify and the 3 highest placed restricted animals will qualify. **Eligible Restricted Riders MUST wear an Armband.** Exhibitors in qualifying positions are allowed 7 days to register. In mixed height open (restricted) classes the 4 highest placed restricted animals will qualify for the restricted section. Exhibitors in qualifying positions who have never been members before are allowed 7 days to register.

RESTRICTED OPEN CLASSES

Riders eligible for the Restricted Qualification must wear an Armband. Any animal that has qualified for the SP, ISRT, SHP, ISH, IWH, or WHP classes at the RIHS or HOYS in the previous or current year is not eligible for the restricted SHP, ISH, IWH or WHP qualification. Any animal that has qualified for nursery stakes at the RIHS in the previous or current year is not eligible for the Restricted Open Nursery stakes qualification. **ALL RULES AS PER 2012 RULE AND SHOW HANDBOOK, except for any new or amended rules as included in this schedule.**

Ruth Lears Challenge Novice Working Hunter. Riders can ride up to two horses in the jumping phase but must select only one horse for the ride/ way of going and conformation section if so required. (no change of rider allowed).

Rosettes to 4th place.

**Entry fees: Class 1 to 4 £5.00 in advance £7.00 on the day
All other classes £8.00 in advance £10 on the day**

Health and Safety: The organiser of this event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must read the rules in the schedule and obey the instructions of the organisers and stewards.

Show rules: Please mark and abide by the organisers notes on legal liability and health and safety.

-In all classes the judge's decision is final

-Classes may be split or amalgamated if entries dictate

-Competitors arriving late may compete at the discretion of the judge

-Any objection must be made to the secretary within fifteen minutes of the completion of the competition concerned, with a deposit of £20 which will be returned if the objection is upheld.

-In all jumping competitions if either the horse or riders falls competitors will be automatically eliminated and will leave the ring before re-mounting

-Correctly fitting hats of the correct standard will be worn at all times

-First aid cover will be on the field, a £2.00 charge towards the cost of first aid cover will be made on each competitor

-All dogs must be kept on leads and please clean up after your dog

-The main yard is out of bounds to anyone other than KRC liveries
